## **General Statement of Duties**

Under general supervision instructs, assigns and oversees the maintenance and repair activities of inmates assigned to the shop. Performs maintenance and repair of equipment and machinery used by the Roads, Bridges and Landfill departments. Reports to the Director of Public Works.

## **Minimum Qualifications**

High school graduate/GED with vocational/ technical school training in the service and repair of mechanical systems including electronic ignitions, fuel injections systems, diesel engines, and manual/automatic transmissions, with three to five years of experience in the repair of light/heavy equipment; or any equivalent combination of training and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities. Must possess a valid S.C. driver's license. Must be able to pass a welding skills test. Must be knowledge of basic engine repair work.
